OFFICIAL RULES



1. Each team will have four members, with one member designated as the Head Chef. The captain will be the contact person. All information, questions, materials, etc. should be handled by the Head Chef.
2. Each team will furnish a minimum of 4 gallons of chili, prepared offsite before arrival at the Boys & Girls Club. There will be a prep area outdoors near the building where each team will have a table to hold and heat their chili. Inside the Club, each team will be assigned 6 foot long table, from which to serve their chili. This table may be decorated by the team.
3. Teams must bring the means to keep their chili hot. Propane can be used outside to keep chili ready until it is needed for serving in the dining area. A smaller quantity is to be maintained at the serving table inside, so a crockpot or chafing dish is recommended there. Head chefs are responsible for ensuring that their team has all necessary cooking supplies.
4. Teams may set up their spaces beginning at 1:00 P.M. on Saturday, November 14th and must be completely set up by 2:30 P.M., when judging will begin. The Club will open for dining at 3:00 P.M.
5. Teams are expected to remain set up and onsite until 7:00 P.M., and each team is responsible for the maintenance and general clean-up of their workspace.
6. All entries need to be received no later than Monday, November 2, 2009.
7. There is no registration fee; however, each team will be given 25 tickets to sell to the event (not mandatory but recommended and appreciated) and must secure at least one \$150.00 sponsor. The tickets are \$5.00 for adults and \$2.00 for children 12 and under. Tickets will be available at the door for \$7.00 for adults and \$4.00 for children 12 and under.

The Boys & Girls Club will furnish the following supplies and equipment: tables, chairs (2 at each team table area), drinks, bowls, cups, napkins, eating utensils, and sample cups for judges. At 6:45PM the following presentations will be made:

- Every Head Chef will receive a complimentary "Chili 4 Kids" apron.
- A popular vote will determine the "C4K People's Choice" award.
- The winner of the "Chili 4 Kids Chili Champ" trophy will be chosen by a panel of judges.
- The team raising the most money in tickets sales and sponsorships will be presented with the "C4K Red Hot Chili Pepper" award.
